# Collaboration *at Sea*

An immersive, funding-focused expedition for the executive directors, program officers, board leaders, and funders building a better system for children, youth, and families touched by criminal justice.



Collaboration at Sea is the most ambitious convening to date – an expedition designed to move the field beyond the typical conference format. Over five days at sea, participants join a living, breathing community of practice, where the conversations that matter most happen at the dinner table, out on the deck, and in the workshop room – free of the distractions that pull people away from organizational life.

Set sail on a round-trip voyage from Fort Lauderdale to Nassau, Bahamas and CocoCay Private Island, this collaborative brings together direct-service leaders, funders, researchers, and lived-experience advocates for structured working sessions, shared meals, and the kind of relationship-building that shapes real, funded partnerships.

### CONFERENCE COSTS EXPLAINED

#### EARLY BIRD

by 12/31/26

**\$200\***

per person

\*Eligible only if the cruise ship deposit is paid on or before 12/31/26.

#### LATE REGISTRATION

by 2/5/27

**\$300\***

per person

\*For those who pay their ship deposit between 1/1/27-2/5/27.

- No credit card fees, no platform fees.

Payment Plan

DUE AT BOOKING:

- **\$200** deposit due at booking plus any payments past their due date

DUE AFTER BOOKING:

Interior Room

- **\$186** - due monthly November-February

Ocean View Room

- **\$207** - due monthly November-February

Balcony Room

- **\$242** - due monthly November-February

- All prices reflect the required double occupancy. One person pays for the room.
- Select the "Shared" room option to request room pairing with a conference attendee.
- All prices will have an additional 3% service fee added.
- Not included: transportation, drink or internet packages, drinks beyond cruise package, specialty restaurant dining, excursions, shopping, spa, gratuities, etc.
- All cruise ship payments are payable to Baileys Luxury Travel through the link provided.
- **Deadline: 2/5/27**

## Collaboration at Sea - 2027 Conference & Cruise Fact Sheet

Conference registration and cruise ship package are two separate costs and must be paid separately to Connecting 4 Justice International (conference) and the travel agency (cruise ship).

### CONFERENCE REGISTRATION COST

**Paid to: Connecting 4 Justice International**

**Early Bird Conference Rate: \$200 per person\***

*\*available through December 31, 2026, provided the cruise deposit has been paid by that date.*

**Late Conference Rate: \$300 per person**

- Conference registration can be purchased individually.
- Your cruise cabinmate does not have to register for the conference. Significant others welcome.
- Conference registration is paid separately from the cruise ship package.
- No credit card or platform fees or taxes charged in registration cost. Charitable receipt will be provided.
- 100% of your payment supports the work of C4JI, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. Thank you.

### CRUISE SHIP COST

**Paid to: Baileys Luxury Travel**

**Base Cost: for a two-person interior stateroom: \$944.00**

- Cruise ship pricing varies depending on the stateroom selected with 3 options to choose from.
- Cruise ship bookings are for double occupancy per stateroom. If you wish to room alone, you will pay the double occupancy rate.
- If you wish to be potentially paired with another conference attendee in a stateroom, call our travel agent, Ms. Radika Bailey at 754-246-6174 and mention "Collaboration at Sea", to be added to a roommate request list. There is an option to pay for your half of a shared room on the cruise ship reservation site.
- A cruise payment plan is available. See the payment schedule for details.
- **Cruise fare includes** your stateroom with daily housekeeping, a variety of meals and casual dining options, select non-alcoholic beverages, and a wide range of entertainment and on board activities.
- Enjoy live shows, music, comedy, trivia, movies, swimming pools, hot tubs, fitness facilities, and sports activities included in your cruise fare.
- **Cruise pricing does NOT include** transportation to or from the ship, specialty dining, drink packages, Wi-Fi package, excursions, shopping, spa services, gratuities/tips, or other personal expenses.

### IMPORTANT DATES

**December 31, 2026** - Deadline to secure \$200 early bird conference rate by paying your cruise deposit.

**January 1, 2027** - Conference registration cost increases to \$300.

**February 5, 2027** - Registration for both the conference and cruise ship closes.

Please note: Cruise pricing is based on a two-person occupancy and will vary based on the stateroom selected. The conference fee is separate and not included in the cruise ship price.
